Open Class:

Ducks will be judged on cleanliness, vigor, health, and color.

Rules & Regulations:

- Ducks must be Purebred Standard variety, crossbreeds will not be accepted.
- No late entries. U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid Certificate must be submitted with entry form.
- Ducks must be tested negative for Pullorum-Typhoid within 90 days of the show.
- Ducks must be 6 months of age or older.
- Ducks will be refused if they have fleas, ticks, parasites, or a disease.
- Entry Fee of \$5.00 must be paid at sign in. Cash Only.
- Any dying or coloring of feathers is prohibited, and results in disqualification.
- Exhibitors selling their birds must stay after the awards ceremony to sell.

Caging Requirements:

- Your cage must be large enough to fit your bird comfortably.
- Food will **not** be provided, you must bring your own.
- We will however, provide water, but you must bring your own bowls.
- Bring a towel or newspaper to put under the duck's cage.

Weight Class Numbers:

In the entry form, there is a column for weight class number.

- Bantams are weight class 1
- Lightweights are weight class 2
- Mediumweights are weight class 3
 - Heavyweights are weight class 4
